ANNOUNCEMENTS

Due to the abundance of announcements required to keep spectators and participants informed at a meet of this stature, public address requests will be restricted to the needs of the competing schools and emergencies only.

CELL PHONES, PAGERS & ELECTRONIC DEVICES

The Games Committee has requested that all spectators, athletes, coaches, media and meet workers near the starting line and near the field event areas, please switch your cellular phones from ring to vibrate mode or completely off to avoid disturbing the competitors. Electronic devices are prohibited in all warm-up and competition areas as defined by the NSAA State Track & Field Games Committee.

EVENT HEADINGS

Each event is presented on a page in this program. Information in the heading includes last year's gold medal winner and their picture. Also included are the class records for the event. There are two sets of records listed: a state meet record and the state record which can be set at the state meet or any meet during the year that qualifies under the NSAA state record standards.

RESULTS

Results in all events are announced via the public address system and are posted on the outside wall of the lower press box, located on the west side of the stadium. Results will also be posted on the message board on the north end of the stadium. Complete results are also available during the meet on the NSAA website – www.nsaahome.org.

HEAT, LANE AND FLIGHT ASSIGNMENT INFORMATION

Competitors in the sprint races (100, 200, 400 and hurdles) are divided into heats according to formulas based on their district finish.

Class A:

Heat 1 – Fastest district champion; second and third fastest second placers; fourth fastest third placer; first fastest fourth placer; second, third and eighth fastest additional qualifiers.

Heat 2 – Second fastest district champion; first and fourth fastest second placers; third fastest third placer; second fastest fourth placer; first, fourth and seventh fastest additional qualifiers.

Heat 3 – Third and fourth fastest district champions; first and second fastest third placers; third and fourth fastest fourth placers; fifth and sixth fastest additional qualifiers.

Class B:

Heat 1 – First and sixth fastest district champions; third and fourth fastest second placers; second and fifth fastest third placers; first and sixth fastest additional qualifiers.

Heat 2 – Second and fifth fastest district champions; first and sixth fastest second placers; third and fourth fastest third placers; second and fifth fastest additional qualifiers.

Heat 3 – Third and fourth fastest district champions; second and fifth fastest second placers; first and sixth fastest third placers; third and fourth fastest additional qualifiers.

Class C & D:

Heat 1 – First, sixth and seventh fastest district champions; third, fourth and ninth fastest second placers; first and sixth fastest additional qualifiers.

Heat 2 – Second, fifth, eighth fastest district champions; second, fifth and eighth fastest second placers; second and fifth fastest additional qualifiers.

Heat 3 – Third, fourth, ninth fastest district champions; first, sixth and seventh fastest second placers; third and fourth fastest additional qualifiers.

Once assigned to a heat, the athletes are placed in lane assignments based on their district performance. The fastest runner is assigned to Lane 4, #2 in Lane 5, #3 in Lane 3, #4 in Lane 6, #5 in Lane 2, #6 in Lane 7, #7 in Lane 1, and #8 in Lane 8.

In all Classes there will be three heats in the 100-, 200-, 400-meter dashes, 300-meter hurdles, and 100- and 110-meter hurdles. The first-place winner in each heat and the next five fastest times will advance to the championship finals on Saturday.

800-meter run, 400-meter relay and 1,600-meter relay – Two sections against time, with the qualifiers times from districts the basis for assignment to sections. The fastest qualifiers will be assigned to second section.

3,200-meter relay – One section to be run in two super alleys. Alley #1 will include the 6th through 16th fastest qualifier. Alley #2 will include the 1st through the 5th fastest qualifier.

1,600-meter run and 3,200-meter run – One section to be run in two super alleys. Alley #1 will include the 9th through 24th fastest qualifier. Alley #2 will include the 1st through 8th fastest qualifier.

In field events, athletes are placed in flights according to district performances. The best performances are placed in the last flight with the best performance listed first within the flight.

2021 NSAA State Track and Field Meet Awards Schedule

Medals will be presented to all place winners, 1st – 8th, for each event. The medal presentations will take place on the podiums located in the north end of the infield.

Coaches and spectators are not allowed on the infield during the medal presentations. An awards platform for pictures is set up outside the south gate entrance for coaches, parents, and spectators to take photos.

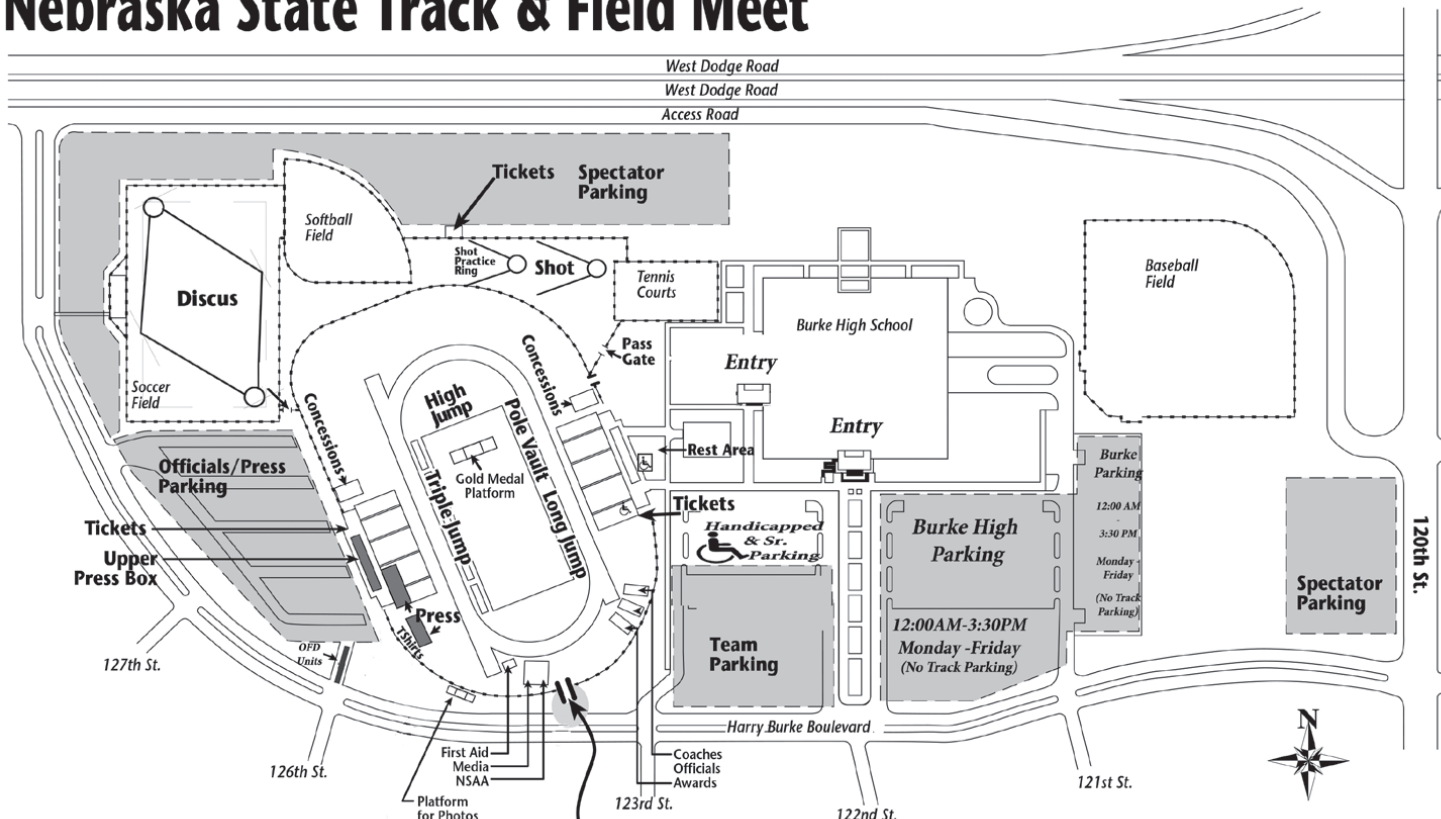

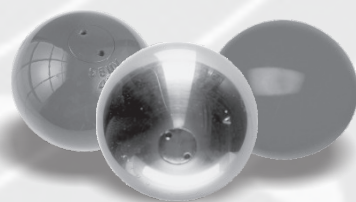

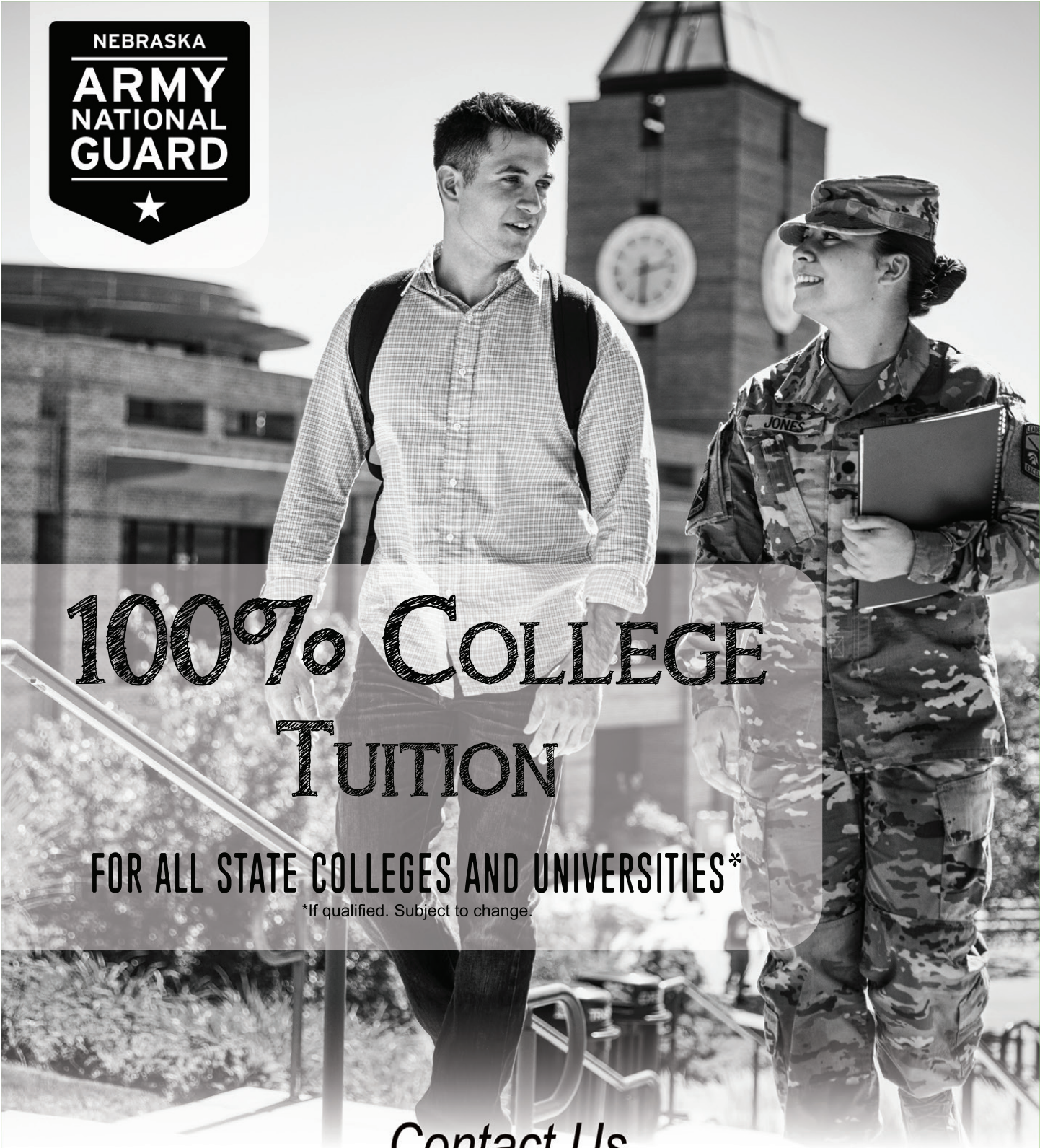
