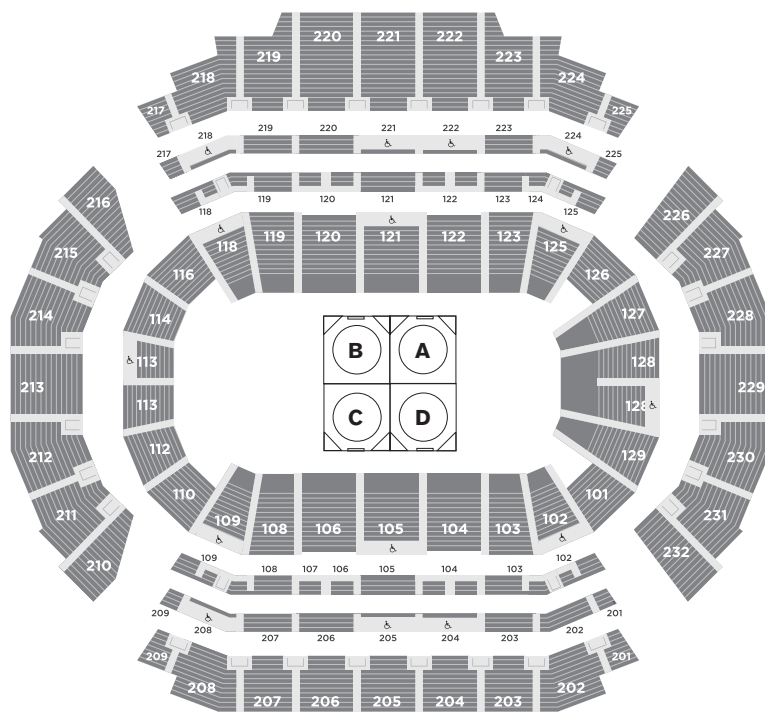

These charts show team points for each round during this tournament, depending on the type or margin of victory. These charts include the appropriate advancement and place points inserted during the progress of the tournament.

For instance, first place is worth 16 points and these will be issued as earned, beginning with a quarterfinal win, where an athlete clinches at least sixth place. Again, after a semifinal win, where the athlete clinches at least second place, and finally with the championship match win, where the athlete picks up the difference in second and first place points. If an athlete wins a first-round match by a fall, the wrestler scores 4 points for the team. If the wrestler wins the quarterfinal match by a decision, add 5 more points to the team total.

In Class D and the girls bracket: *Any school that qualifies more than one wrestler in a weight class, must designate which of the two wrestlers would score team points for the purpose of determining the state team placing. If two wrestlers from the same school compete against each other in the tournament, and the designated scoring wrestler wins the match, only advancement and placement points for that match would be awarded with no additional bonus points earned regardless of the match score.*
