



ACADEMIC ALL-STATE AWARDS

Each year the Nebraska School Activities Association and a corporate partner will recognize students who have been nominated by their schools, based on their individual academic excellence and significant contributions made to their NSAA activity.

Every student who meets the criteria for nomination by their school will be recognized and awarded a certificate of achievement by the NSAA and the supporting corporate partner of the Academic All-State Awards program.

The following leadership and scholarship guidelines shall apply:

1. A nominated student must be a **varsity player** or **organizational leader** who has played a significant role on the team or in the organizational activity during the seasons for which nominations are accepted.
2. A nominated student must have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average, in all curricular subjects, of **93% or 3.7 on a 4.0-point scale** or the equivalent.
3. NSAA high schools or their cooperative sponsorship may nominate a maximum of two students per NSAA activity program.

Students who meet these requirements and are nominated by their school administration shall be awarded the NSAA Academic All-State Award for that activity.
