



ACADEMIC ALL-STATE AWARDS

This new awards program began in 2006 and allows NSAA member schools to nominate those students who have represented their community by demonstrating high levels of academic and activity program leadership. During the 3 major NSAA event seasons the Nebraska School Activities Association and supporting sponsor will recognize students who have been nominated by their schools for this prestigious award.

Every student who meets the criteria for nomination by their school will be recognized and awarded the Academic All-State Award.

The following leadership and scholarship guidelines shall apply:

1. A nominated student must be a **varsity player** or **organizational leader** who has played a significant role on the team or in the organizational activity during the seasons for which nominations are accepted.
2. A nominated student must have a minimum cumulative Grade Point Average, in all curricular subjects, of **93% on a 100% scale** or **3.7 on a 4.0-point scale** or the equivalent.
3. NSAA high schools or their cooperative sponsorship may nominate a maximum of two students per NSAA activity program.

During the 2008-2009 academic year more than 5,200 students across Nebraska were nominated and received Academic All-State Awards. Three times each year local media outlets report on the students who have been awarded this honor. This major sponsorship platform offers statewide exposure on a year-round basis.
