Technical Skill	Crew members demonstrate an advanced knowledge of the technical requirements for their show's performance and display all the skills necessary to meet those requirements. Light and sound technicians listen carefully to the instructions given to them by the host stage technicians and follow them.	Crew members demonstrate more than adequate knowledge of the technical requirements for their show's performance and display most of the necessary skills to meet those requirements. Light and sound technicians listen to the instructions given to them by the host stage technicians and follow most of them .	Crew members demonstrate a fairly adequate knowledge of the technical requirements of their show's performance and display some of the necessary skills to meet those requirements. Light and sound technicians haphazardly listen to the instructions given to them by the host stage technicians and somewhat follow them.
Organization	Crew members set up and tear down the set in a very organized manner. They use their preset time very efficiently making sure they don't impede another show's set up or tear down. They have all the tools and materials they need to accomplish their tasks.	Crew members set up and tear down the set in a fairly organized manner. They use their preset time somewhat efficiently and try to not impede another show's set up or tear down. They have most of the tools and materials they need to accomplish their tasks.	Crew members are somewhat organized in their set up and tear down. They do not use their preset time efficiently and occasionally interfere with another show's set up or tear down. They lack the tools and materials they need to accomplish their tasks.
Neatness	Crew members leave no footprint of their show on the stage. They move set pieces and props carefully , so as not to damage the stage and acting area. They clean up after themselves in a quick efficient manner so as not to hinder the next show's set up or performance.	Crew members leave some evidence of their show on the stage. They occasionally leave marks on the stage from the set pieces and the props. They mostly clean up after themselves in a quick and efficient manner and try not to hinder the next show's set up or performance.	Crew members leave evidence of their show on the stage. They damage the stage with their set pieces and the props. They clean up haphazardly after themselves leaving some mess on the stage which could hinder the next show's set up or performance.
