UNIFIED SPORTS RESEARCH FINDINGS

Unified Sports

- Has a **positive impact** on all participants
 - 79% of Unified Partners reported talking to a student with ID during free time at school and 41% reported eating lunch with a student with ID.
- Improves understanding of people with intellectual disabilities
- Complements social inclusion within the school community
- Is significantly influenced by commitment and attitude of staff
