

2.7.6 Home School Bylaws

Due to the amendment of Nebraska State Statute 79-2,136, the NSAA Board of Directors adopted the amended standing determination for participation of part-time (home school) students effective July 1, 2023.

For home school students to participate in NSAA activities at a member school the following eligibility requirements must be met:

- 1. Must be continuously enrolled in at least 5 credit hours per semester at the member school.
- 2. If attending a member high school for the first time as a 9th grade student, the student may attend any member high school.
- 3. If the student is a 10th, 11th or 12th grade student, the student is considered a transfer student and shall be ineligible for varsity competition for ninety school days unless the home school is located in the same school district as the high school to which the student is transferring.
- 4. If the student enters a member school as a 10th, 11th or 12th grade student, the student shall have received, or be granted, twenty credit hours for the immediate preceding semester. The twenty credit hours must be accepted and entered on the records of the student as partial fulfillment of the school's graduation requirements. The member school shall determine whether the home school credits will be accepted to fulfill preceding semester scholastic requirements.
- 5. Further, home school students who are enrolled in subsequent semesters must have successfully completed 20 credit hours in the immediate preceding semester, of which at least 5 of those credit hours must have been earned at the member school.
- 6. Students who enrolled in grades nine, ten, eleven, or twelve at a home school and who transfer to a member high school, shall be credited with the number of semesters of high school membership in which they were a member of the home school. These students shall not exceed 8 semesters of school membership beginning with the initial enrollment in grade nine or the equivalent of grade nine.

Home school students must also meet all other member school and NSAA requirements to participate.
