RULES SUMMARY FOR QUAIL RUN GOLF COURSE (CLASS B)

The following summary of this year's host course is provided to teams in advance so they'll be better prepared for state golf from a Rules of Golf perspective. We encourage participating teams to review this document prior to their arrival.

QUAIL RUN GOLF COURSE:

See the NSAA's course set-up for specific championship yardage.

Front Nine - Hole #1 - Out of Bounds down the right side defined by fence posts and white stakes; a ditch just off the tee to the left is a Lateral Water Hazard (red); The windmill is an Immovable Obstruction with relief for physical interference only, there is no relief for line of play. **Hole #2** - A Lateral Water Hazard (red) runs down the right side, the pond located left of the putting green is also a Lateral Water Hazard (red). **Hole #3** - Out of Bounds runs the entire right side of the hole defined by white stakes. **Hole #4** - Out of Bounds runs along the right side defined by the fence posts; The pond along the left is a Lateral Water Hazard (red). **Hole #5** - The pond along the immediate left is a Lateral Water Hazard (red); Out of Bounds runs along the right side defined by the fence posts. **Hole #6** - Out of Bounds runs along the right defined by white stakes. **Hole #7** - Out of Bounds runs along the right side defined by white stakes and the fence posts; there is an area near the green along the right that is a Lateral Water Hazard (red). **Hole #8** - Out of Bounds is located behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #9** - Out of Bounds runs along the left side defined by white stakes and the posts of the driving range net, it is also behind the green defined by white stakes; Lateral Water Hazards (red) are present in the landing area along both the left and right.

Back Nine - Hole #10 - Out of Bounds down the left side defined by white stakes; The pond right of the putting green is a Lateral Water Hazard (red). **Hole #12** - The pond behind the putting green is a Lateral Water Hazard (red). **Hole #13** - The lake along the left is a Lateral Water Hazard (red), a Drop Zone is provided near the corner of the lake as an additional option when taking relief for a ball in this Lateral Water Hazard; the walls associated with this Lateral Water Hazard are considered an Integral Part of the Course, therefore there is no relief for interference from it. **Hole #15** - The lake along the left is a Lateral Water Hazard (red), a Drop Zone is provided near the corner of the lake as an additional option when taking relief for a ball in this Lateral Water Hazard; the walls associated with this Lateral Water Hazard are considered an Integral Part of the Course, therefore there is no relief for interference from it. **Hole #18** - Out of Bounds runs along the right side defined by fence posts and behind the putting green defined by the large white parking posts; Lateral Water Hazards (red) are present in the landing area along both the left and right.

As a reminder, if a ball is Out of Bounds the player must play a ball, under penalty of one stroke, as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule 20-5). For options under the Lateral Water Hazard rule see Rule 26-1. All flower beds are to be treated as Ground Under Repair so players may receive relief for physical interference from these areas. Turf areas damaged by animals may also be treated as Ground Under Repair but only when you receive approval from a Rules Official.
