RULES SUMMARY FOR LAKE MALONEY GOLF CLUB (CLASS C)

The following summary of this year's host course is provided to teams in advance so they'll be better prepared for state golf from a Rules of Golf perspective. We encourage participating teams to review this document prior to their arrival.

LAKE MALONEY GOLF CLUB:

See the NSAA's course set-up for specific championship yardage.

Front Nine - Hole #1 - Out of Bounds down the left side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #2** - Out of Bounds down the left side defined by white stakes. **Hole #3** - Out of Bounds down the left side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #5** - Out of Bounds down the left side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #7** - Out of Bounds down the left side defined by white stakes. **Hole #8** - Out of Bounds down the left side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #9** - Out of Bounds down the left side and behind the green defined by white stakes.

Back Nine - Hole #10 - Out of Bounds down the right side and behind the green defined by white stakes and the fence line. **Hole #11** - Out of Bounds down the right side defined by the fence line. **Hole #12** - Out of Bounds down the right side defined by white stakes. **Hole #13** - Out of Bounds down the right side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #14** - Out of Bounds down the right side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #15** - Out of Bounds down the right side and behind the green defined by white stakes and a white line. **Hole #16** - Out of Bounds just off the tee on the right side defined by white stakes. **Hole #17** - Out of Bounds down the right side and behind the green defined by white stakes. **Hole #18** - Out of Bounds down the right side defined by white stakes.

As a reminder, if a ball is Out of Bounds the player must play a ball, under penalty of one stroke, as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule 20-5). All flower and plant beds are to be treated as Ground Under Repair so players may receive relief for physical interference from these areas. Flower and Plant beds encircled or adjacent to an Immovable Obstruction have the same status of an Immovable Obstruction.

There are some sprinkler heads on putting greens. In addition to relief for physical interference from these sprinkler heads, a player may also receive relief for their "line of putt" if the ball lies on the putting green. Off the putting green, a player may also receive relief for interference from an immovable obstruction along the "line of play" between the ball and the hole if the immovable obstruction is located within two club lengths of the putting green and the ball is within two club lengths of the immovable obstruction (not available if the ball is in a bunker).
