NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NSAA Golf Events)

Teeing Ground:

The Blue Tee Markers define the teeing ground for the competition.

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Flower and plant beds are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. Rule 25-1.

Staked Trees identified by stakes and wire are deemed to be ground under repair even though not so defined by white lines. Rule 25-1.

Rock borders surrounding flower and plant beds have the same status as flower and plant beds, that of Ground Under Repair. Rule 25-1.

Deciding Ties:

In the event of a tie for first place in either the individual or team competition, a hole-by-hole play-off will determine the champion. Please see the NSAA Golf Manual for details on such play-off procedures.

Drop Zones:

Hole #2 – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the water hazard or lateral water hazard, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked “DZ” located on the forward teeing ground.

Hole #13 – As an additional option under Rule 24-2 (including intervention for line of play from the protective fence right of the green), the player may drop the ball on the closest of the two zones marked “DZ” located at the north and south ends of the protective fence.

Integral Part of the Course:

The rock wall located within the margin of the Water Hazard on hole #2 is deemed to be an Integral Part of the Course, therefore no relief without penalty.

The mulch bed behind No. 10 green is deemed to be an Integral Part of the Course, therefore no relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

Flower and plant beds enclosed by roads and paths have the same status as the roads and paths, that of obstructions.

Yardage posts are deemed to be movable obstructions. Rule 24-1.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by perimeter and pool fence in addition to white stakes and white dots and lines. The parking lot is Out of Bounds.

Scoring Area:

The scoring area is defined by the area under the tent near the 9th and 18th putting greens.

Temporary Immovable Obstruction:

The starting and scoring tent(s) are temporary immovable obstructions; relief may be taken on either side in accordance with Appendix I of the Rules of Golf.

Transportation:

Players may accept transportation from #10 putting green to #11 tee and from #16 putting green to #17 tee, otherwise players must walk at all times.
