NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NSAA Golf Events)

Abnormal Ground Conditions:

Flower Beds are deemed to be Ground Under Repair even though not so defined by white lines. Rule 25-1.

Drop Zones:

<u>Lateral Water Hazard on Hole #13</u> – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the *Lateral Water Hazard*, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked "DZ".

<u>Lateral Water Hazard on Hole #15</u> – As an additional option under Rule 26-1, if a ball is in the *Lateral Water Hazard*, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the area marked "DZ".

Integral Parts of the Course:

<u>Retaining Walls located within Lateral Water Hazards</u> are deemed to be an *Integral Part of the Course*. No relief without penalty.

Obstructions:

Hole #1 - The windmill located along the left side is an Immovable Obstruction. Rule 24-2.

<u>Staked Trees</u> are deemed to be *Immovable Obstructions*. Rule 24-2.

Rain Shelters – All rain shelters located on the course are *Immovable Obstructions*. Rule 24-2.

Yardage Plates are deemed to be Immovable Obstructions. Rule 24-2.

Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths include those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt.

Out of Bounds:

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence, posts and white lines in addition to white stakes.

Hole #9 – In addition to white stakes and posts, Out of Bounds is defined by the driving range poles along the left side.

Play-Off:

In case of a tie for first place in either the individual or team competition, concerned players shall immediately *Play-Off* hole-by-hole until a winner is determined. The *Play-Off* rotation will be Holes 1-2-8-9 unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

Scoring Area:

Scoring Area – A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring area.

Teeing Ground:

Gold Tee Markers define the *Teeing Ground* for the competition.

Transportation:

Players must walk at all times during the stipulated round.
