### **RULES SUMMARY FOR RIVER'S EDGE GOLF CLUB (CLASS C)**

The following summary of this year's host course is provided to teams in advance so they'll be better prepared for state golf from a Rules of Golf perspective. We encourage participating teams to review this document prior to their arrival.

#### **RIVER'S EDGE GOLF CLUB:**

See the NSAA's course set-up for specific championship yardage.

**Front Nine - Hole #1** - Out of Bounds along the right side and behind the putting green defined by white stakes. **Hole #2** - Lateral Water Hazard (red) along the left side and behind the putting green; Out of Bounds along the right side defined by the fence. **Hole #3** - Water Hazard (yellow) in front of the tee; Out of Bounds along the right side defined by the fence. **Hole #4** - Water Hazard (yellow) front left of the putting green; Out of Bounds along the right side defined by the fence. **Hole #5** - Lateral Water Hazard (red) along the left side; Out of Bounds along the right side defined by the fence. **Hole #6** - Out of Bounds along the right side defined by the fence. **Hole #8** - Water Hazard (yellow) near the fairway on both left and right sides; Out of Bounds behind the green defined by the fence. **Hole #9** - Out of Bounds along the right side defined by the fence; Water Hazard (yellow) crossing the fairway.

**Back Nine - Hole #11** - Lateral Water Hazard (red) along the left and right sides. **Hole #12** - Water Hazard (yellow) in front of the tee. **Hole #13** - Lateral Water Hazard (red) along the right side. **Hole #14** - Water Hazard (yellow) along the right side. **Hole #16** - Lateral Water Hazard (red) behind the putting green. **Hole #18** - Water Hazard (yellow) in front of the tee and in front of the putting green; Lateral Water Hazard (red) along the right side.

As a reminder, if a ball is Out of Bounds the player must play a ball, under penalty of one stroke, as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was last played (see Rule 20-5). Objects identifying or defining Out of Bounds are fixed and may not be moved; relief without penalty is prohibited.

All flower and plant beds are to be treated as Ground Under Repair so players may receive relief for physical interference from these areas. Turf areas damaged by animals may also be treated as Ground Under Repair but only when you receive approval from a Rules Official.
