**NOTICE TO COMPETITORS**

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Conditions of Competition for NSAA Golf Events)

**Abnormal Ground Conditions:**

Areas of Unusual Turf Damage Created by Animals (i.e. raccoons, skunks and the like) may be considered *Ground Under Repair*, but only when so declared by a Rules Official. Rule 25-1.

Flower and Plant Beds are deemed to be *Ground Under Repair* even though not so defined by white lines. Rule 25-1.

**Obstructions:**

Yardage Posts are deemed to be *Movable Obstructions*. Rule 24-1.

Flower and plant beds enclosed by roads and paths have the same status as the roads and paths, that of obstructions.

**Out of Bounds:**

Out of Bounds is defined by the perimeter fence in addition to white stakes.

**Play-Off:**

In case of a tie for first place in either the individual or team competition, concerned players shall immediately *Play-Off* hole-by-hole until a winner is determined. The *Play-Off* rotation will be Holes 10-11-18 unless otherwise notified by the Committee.

**Scoring Area:**

Scoring Area – A scorecard is deemed to be returned when the player has left the scoring area.

**Teeing Ground:**

Red Tee Markers define the *Teeing Ground* for the competition.

**Transportation:**

Players must walk at all times during the stipulated round.

**Water Hazards and Lateral Water Hazards:**

Hole #11 - The pond marked as a Water Hazard (yellow) along the left side plays as a Lateral Water Hazard during play of Hole #11.
