NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for 2019 NSAA Golf Championships & Events)

- 1. <u>Deciding Ties:</u> In the event of a tie for first place in either the individual or team competition, a hole-by-hole play-off using holes 16-18 will determine the champion. See the NSAA Golf Manual for play-off procedure.
- 2. <u>Teeing Ground:</u> The Black Tee-Markers define the teeing area.

3. Transportation:

- a. Permitted during play when going **from hole 18 to hole 1**.
- 4. <u>Scoring Area</u>: A scorecard is treated as returned when the player has left the scoring area defined white line surrounding the tent, unless the player, prior to leaving, verbally informs a Scoring Official, and it is acknowledged, of his intention to leave the scoring area and immediately return.

5. Out of Bounds:

- a. Out of Bounds is defined by white lines in addition to white stakes and fence posts. When defined by white lines, the line itself is out of bounds.
- b. The Parking Lot and Entrance Road. A ball is out of bounds when all of it lies beyond the curbing even though it might lay on another part of the golf course.

6. Bunkers:

a. Hole 3 - The bunker along the left is treated as part of the General Area.

7. <u>Penalty Areas:</u>

a. **Dropping Zone:** If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the **Yellow Penalty Area on Hole 8**, the player may proceed (i) under Rule 17.1 or (ii) as an extra option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke in the dropping zone located in the fairway. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

8. Immovable Obstructions include, but are not limited to:

- a. Newly Planted Trees identified by ribbon and their tree wells.
- b. Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths including those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt.
- c. Immovable Obstructions Adjacent to Each Other are to be treated as a single immovable obstruction.
- d. **Hole 15** The cart staging area, clubhouse, cart barn and split rail fence are treated as one immovable obstruction.
- e. **Dropping Zone:** During play of **hole 15**, if a ball has interference from the area defined in Heading 6d. above, the player may proceed (i) under Rule 16.1b. or (ii) as an extra option, drop a ball in the dropping zone located in the rough behind the putting green. The dropping zone is a relief area under Rule 14.3.

9. <u>Temporary Immovable Obstructions:</u>

a. **Relief on Either Side:** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect and includes any temporary immovable obstruction installed for the championship. If a player has either physical interference or line of sight interference from any TIO and is entitled to relief, as an additional option, he may take relief on the other side of the TIO along the arc without penalty. When taking relief on the other side of the TIO, the player may only take relief under the TIO Local Rule, not Rule 16.1.

10. Integral Objects:

- a. Rock bed bordering the entrance road (free relief not permitted).
- 11. <u>Final Decisions on Any Disputed Points</u> will be made by Nate Neuhaus, NSAA; John Cannella, NGA and Scott Bruha, Meadowlark Hills GC.
