



Points for Advancement and Place are Awarded During the Course of the Tournament

This chart shows team points for each round during this tournament, depending on the type or margin of victory. This chart includes the appropriate advancement and place points inserted during the progress of the tournament.

For instance, first place is worth 16 points and these will be issued in takes, beginning with a quarterfinal win, where an athlete clinches at least sixth place. Again after a semifinal win, where the athlete clinches at least second place, and finally with the championship match win, where the athlete picks up the difference in second and first place points. If an athlete wins a first round match by a fall, the wrestler scores 4 points for the team. If the wrestler wins the quarterfinal match by a decision, add 5 more points to the team total.

The NSAA follows the National Federation of State High School Association's wrestling rules in staging doubleelimination competition for all weight classes at the individual state championships.

This means every athlete is guaranteed two matches, giving any one of the first-round losers the opportunity to come back and be a third-place finisher.

This page illustrates to state tournament spectators where the wrestlers will be placed on the consolation bracket. The brackets on this page are similar to those on each weight class page. The winners of the paired wrestling matches will move out to the next line on the bracket. The numbers show where the loser of the match will be placed on the consolation bracket.

The match number is listed on the brackets to help spectators track wrestlers and their matches.


You can see this means the first names going on the consolation bracket are the losers of the first-round matches. They'll be paired for the first-round consolation matches and the losers there will be eliminated.

Cross-bracketing takes place after the quarterfinals. That means the quarterfinal losers in the top half of the championship bracket are placed in the lower half of the consolation bracket, and the lower half quarterfinal losers go on the top half of the consolation bracket.

The semifinal losers are not cross-bracketed. The results of all matches are posted in the north end and southeast corner of the main spectator level of the CenturyLink Center for your convenience.

Brackets and team scores will be updated as the tournament progresses.

To participate in the individual state championships, an athlete had to finish in the top four of a district tournament. The four district champions in each weight class are co-seeded No. 1. The district runners-up are co-seeded No. 5, the third-place district finishers co-seeded No. 9, and the fourth-place finishers are co-seeded No. 13. Three different formulas are used so the athletes from one district don't always compete against all athletes from another district. The district champions will be matched against a first round. The second and third place district finishers are then paired for the opening round.
