NSAA DUAL WRESTLING QUALIFYING CRITERIA

The four team champions from each respective NSAA Wrestling District Championship held Feb. 8 & 9 automatically qualified for these championships. The remaining four teams from each class were determined by the following point system:

- 1. Total district team points
- 2. 10 points per wrestler entered in the district tournament (minimum of 10)
- 3. 5 points per state qualifier

The total points from 1, 2 and 3 were totaled to determine the remaining team qualifiers for the Dual Championships.

Ties for qualifying spots or higher seed, were broken as follows:

- 1. The team with the most team points from the district tournament shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 2. The team with the most wrestlers entered in the district tournament shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:

- 3. The team with the most state individual qualifiers shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 4. The team with the most District Champions shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 5. The team with the most District Runner-ups shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 6. The team with the most District Third-place finishers shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 7. The team with the most District Consolation Semifinalists shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 8. The team with the Higher District Team Place shall earn the qualifying spot or higher seed. If still tied:
- 9. Flip a coin.

All of the qualifying teams in each class were seeded in an eight-team bracket according to the point system.
