NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

(This information supplements the Local Rules and Terms of the Competition for 2020 NSAA Golf Championships & Events)

1. **Electronic Scoring:** A player may use a cell phone or another type of electronic device for scoring purposes only.
2. **Deciding Ties:** In the event of a tie for first place in the individual or team competition, a hole-by-hole play-off using holes 1 & 9 will determine the champion unless otherwise notified by the Committee. See the NSAA Golf Manual for play-off procedure.
3. **Teeing Ground:** The Red Tee-Markers define the teeing area.
4. **Scoring Area:** A player's scorecard is deemed to be returned when both the player and marker both verbally certify the player's hole-by-hole scores and the player has left the scoring area.
5. **Out of Bounds:**
 - a. Out of Bounds is defined by white lines in addition to white stakes, white posts, white paint dots and fence posts. When defined by white lines, the line itself is out of bounds.
 - b. **Hole 12 & Hole 14** - Out of Bounds is defined by the curbing of the street behind the putting green. A ball is out of bounds if it lies beyond the curbing even though it might be on another part of the golf course.
6. **Ground Under Repair** includes, but is not limited to:
 - a. Decorative Flower and Plant Beds. When enclosed by cart paths or adjacent to immovable obstructions they are treated as a single abnormal course condition.
 - b. The Tree Nursery Area between holes 16, 17 & 18, identified by white stakes with green tops and defined by a white line.
7. **Movable Obstructions** include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Yardage posts.
8. **Immovable Obstructions** include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Staked Trees.
 - b. Artificially Surfaced Roads and Paths including those surfaced with crushed brick, gravel or asphalt.
 - c. **Holes 10, 15 and 16** – The Maintenance Road adjacent to the canal.
 - d. **Immovable Obstructions Adjacent to Each Other** are to be treated as a single immovable obstruction.
9. **Temporary Immovable Obstructions:**
 - a. **Relief on Either Side:** Model Local Rule F-23 is in effect and includes any temporary immovable obstruction installed for the championship. If a player has either physical interference or line of sight interference from any TIO and is entitled to relief, as an additional option, she may take relief on the other side of the TIO along the arc without penalty. When taking relief on the other side of the TIO, the player may only take relief under the TIO Local Rule, not Rule 16.1.
10. **Loose Impediments:**
 - a. Mulch used as decoration for tree bases.
11. **Final Decisions on Any Disputed Points** will be made by Jeff Stauss, NSAA; Ben Vigil, NGA and Robert Thomason, Monument Shadows GC.
