DOWNTOWN PARKING INFORMATION

The City of Lincoln welcomes visitors attending the State High School Basketball Tournaments and would like to remind you about downtown parking options. The Red 1 garage is located across the street from the Pinnacle Bank Arena. Reserve a space for only \$8 by visiting parkandgo.org and clicking on Event Parking. No reservation? The pre-pay rate is \$8, credit card only, at the Red 1, Green 2, and Blue 3 garage entrances. Other Park & Go garages give you the First Hour FREE, \$1.25 per hour, with a maximum of \$11.25 for all-day parking. Pay with a credit card when exiting. For more information about parking rules and regulations, visit the Parking Services website at parkandgo.org or call them at 402-441-PARK (7275).

Parking meters: Pay by phone using the PassportParking app. Download it from Google Play or the App Store. When creating a new session, use the Zone posted on the meter to park by the hour. Use **Zone 90** to park at any meter all-day for only \$10. <https://qrco.de/bclCCF> Valid Monday-Saturday, March 7-12, 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Parking meters are enforced Monday-Saturday, from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and time limits range from 30 minutes to 10 hours. They are \$1.25 an hour for most meters. 10-hour meters are \$0.75 an hour.

Downtown: Approximately 20,000 spaces are available in metered, on-street spaces, and parking lots or garages available for general public use daily. The city's Parking Services Division operates all city parking facilities and can be contacted at 402-441-PARK (7275). Parking for oversize vehicles can be arranged by calling Pinnacle Bank Arena at (402) 904-4444 or Polygon Corp at (402) 770-7659.

PINNACLE BANK ARENA PARKING

Public parking will be available on a first-come, first-served basis, all days in the Festival Space and premium garage for \$5.00.

All team filled buses will utilize Gate 2 to park their bus and enter the arena. Only buses with teams and coaches will be allowed to utilize this gate for parking. They will enter the arena through the door on the right-hand side of Dock 1. There will be attendants present to assist with this and a sign that states, "Team Entrance."

Gate 4 will be for NSAA officials and is a permit parking only gate.

All cheerleaders, bands, etc. can be dropped off on R Street in front of the arena and then we ask that the buses park in the Festival Space at no charge. If they aren't dropping off, they are more than welcome to use the pedestrian bridge to come over to the arena. There will only be westbound traffic in front of the arena for drop off, eastbound will be closed to all traffic off of Arena Drive. All bands must enter the building on the south side through the main entrance. They will not be allowed to enter through the team entrance.

Devaney Sports Center | University Lots 50, 52, 56, 58 & 59, \$8.00 per entry (no re-entry allowed without paying \$8.00 fee each time). From the west, enter on North Antelope Valley Parkway and West Entrance Road. From the east off 27th Street, enter at Entrance 4, off of Salt Creek Roadway. Parking will be in the lot on the north side of Devaney Sports Center in Innovation Campus.

Lincoln East High School | Free parking is available in the school parking lot.

Lincoln High School | Free parking is available in the school parking lot.

Lincoln Northeast High School | Free parking is available in the school parking lot.

Lincoln North Star High School | Free parking is available in the school parking lot.

Lincoln Southeast High School | Free parking is available in the school parking lot.

Lincoln Southwest High School | Free parking is available in the school parking lot.
