RULES SUMMARY FOR NORFOLK COUNTRY CLUB (CLASS A)

The following summary of this year's host course is provided to teams in advance so they'll be better prepared for state golf from a Rules of Golf perspective. We encourage participating teams to review this document prior to their arrival at **RIVERSIDE GOLF CLUB**.

See the NSAA's course set-up for specific championship yardage.

Front Nine - **Hole** #5 - Yellow Penalty Area in front of the Teeing Area and Red Penalty Area along the left side. **Hole** #6 - Red Penalty Area behind the Putting Green. **Hole** #7 - Out of Bounds behind the Putting Green defined by white stakes. **Hole** #8 - Out of Bounds along the left defined by white stakes or the fence. Yellow Penalty Area in front of the Putting Green. Red Penalty Area left of the Putting Green. **Hole** #9 - Out of Bounds along the left defined by white stakes and along the right defined by the course side edge of the parking lot and entrance road. Red Penalty Area along the left side.

Back Nine - **Hole #11** - Red Penalty Area along the right. **Hole #13** - Out of Bounds along the right defined by fence or white stakes. Yellow Penalty Area in front of the Putting Green. Red Penalty Area right of the Putting Green. **Hole #14** - Out of Bounds along the right defined by perimeter fence. If a ball comes to rest between the two green stakes and it is declared unplayable because of interference from the fence, the player may drop a ball under penalty of one stroke on the closest of the two areas marked "DZ" located near the fence line. Red Penalty Area along the left. **Hole #15** - Out of Bounds along the right defined by perimeter fence. Mulch path along the right next to the perimeter fence is an Integral Object, no relief without penalty. **Hole #16** - Out of Bounds along the right defined by perimeter fence. **Hole #18** - Out of Bounds along the right and behind the Putting Green defined by perimeter fence or white stakes.

As a reminder, if a ball is Out of Bounds, the player must take stroke-and-distance relief by adding one penalty stroke and playing a ball from where the previous stroke was made (see Rule 14.6). Artificial objects defining or showing Out of Bounds may not be moved; free relief is not permitted.

All flower and plant beds are to be treated as Ground Under Repair so players may receive relief for physical interference from these areas. The green 150 yard posts located near the fairway are Movable Obstructions. Rubber mulch associated with cart paths are loose impediments.
