

# State Play Production Frequently Asked Questions

Due to the safety of students at Norfolk Senior High there are some changes for the 2023 State Play Competition. Please refer to the FAQ list for information.

- 1.) Is my bus driver allowed inside of the school?
  - a. No, due to the safety of the students, they will not be allowed inside of the school. They can however, purchase tickets to watch the performances.
  
- 2.) Will the concessions stand be open?
  - a. When school is in session, only performers will have access. After 4p.m. it will be open to everyone.
  - b. On Friday there is no school and will be open to everyone all day.
  
- 3.) Will Norfolk Senior High be in session during state play production?
  - a. Their schedule is as follows, expect heavy traffic during arrival and dismissal times, please plan accordingly.
    - i. Wednesday, Dec. 6, 8 a.m.-3:30 p.m.
    - ii. Thursday, Dec. 7, 8 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
    - iii. Friday, Dec. 8, no school
  
- 4.) Am I able to go to the small gym to see my performer?
  - a. No, parents will not be allowed outside of the Johnny Carson Theatre area.
    - i. If parents are part of the prep crew, the school will need to include them on a list for NSAA and equip them with an NSAA provided wristband. After the performance is done, they will need to remain in the Johnny Carson Theatre area.
  
- 5.) Are tickets available at the theatre?
