Welcome to Lincoln!

The Nebraska State Basketball Championship tournaments provide special opportunities for the athletes and coaches who have worked hard and won a place in the Nebraska School Activities Association state finals. Visit Lincoln recognizes the importance of this achievement and wants to make this visit a true championship experience! To welcome the high school basketball players from your area, we offer the following information.

For girls state basketball, Wednesday-Friday, February 28 - March 2, games are played at Pinnacle Bank Arena and Devaney Sports Center. On Saturday, March 2, championship games will be played at Pinnacle Bank Arena and consolation games played at Lincoln East High School. For boys state basketball, Wednesday-Friday, March 6 - 8, games are played at Pinnacle Bank Arena and Devaney Sports Center. On Saturday, March 9, championship games will be played at Pinnacle Bank Arena and consolation games played at Lincoln Northwest High School.

Pinnacle Bank Arena Parking

Public parking will be available on a first come, first served basis, all days in the Festival Space and premium garage for \$10.00.

All team-filled buses can utilize Gate 2 to park their bus and enter the arena. Only buses with teams and coaches will be allowed to utilize this gate for parking. They will enter into the arena through the door on the right-hand side of Dock 1. There will be attendants present to assist with this and a sign that states, "Team Entrance."

Gate 4 will be for NSAA officials and is a permit parking only gate.

All cheerleaders, bands, etc. can be dropped off on R Street in front of the arena and then we ask that the buses park in the Festival Space at no charge. If they aren't dropping off, they are more than welcome to use the pedestrian bridge to come over to the arena. There will be no street closures for any of these days. All bands must enter into the building on the south side through the main entrance. They will not be allowed to enter through the team entrance.

Downtown Parking Information

The Red 1 Garage is located across the street from the Pinnacle Bank Arena. Reserve a space for only \$8 by visiting parkandgo.org and clicking on "event parking." No reservation? The pre-pay rate is \$8, credit card only, at the Red 1, Green 2 and Blue 3 Garage entrances. Other Park and Go garages give you the first hour FREE, \$1.25 per hour, with a maximum of \$11.25 for all-day parking. Pay with a credit card when exiting. For more information about parking rules and regulations, visit the Parking Services website at parkandgo.org or call them at 402-441-PARK (7275).

Parking meters: Pay by phone using the PassportParking app, which can be downloaded from Google Play or the App Store. When creating a new session, use the Zone posted on the meter to park by the hour. Use Zone 90 to park at any meter all-day for only \$10. (<https://grco.de/bclCCF>). Most meters are \$1.25 an hour and 10-hour meters are \$0.75 an hour.

Downtown: Approximately 20,000 spaces are available in metered, on-street spaces and parking lots or garages available for general public use daily. The city's Parking Services Division operates all city parking facilities and can be contacted at 402-441- PARK (7275). Parking for oversize vehicles can be arranged by calling Pinnacle Bank Arena at (402) 904-4444 or Polygon Corp at (402) 770-7659.
