The film's composer Thomas Newman and Michael Matosic respectively handled the music and lyrics with Lauv. The song plays during the montage of the dates of Ember Lumen and Wade Ripple, two of the main characters, respectively, as well as the end credits. It was released on June 2, 2023 as a single, two weeks before the film's release.
- According to an interview Lauv gave with Rolling Stone, “I saw an early storyboard...and just heard a little about Pete's story and what inspired him in creating this. And I really related, you know, I am a huge lover, and I really related to the love aspect to the film. I basically kind of wanted to create this song that had this feeling of someone coming into your life and totally changing everything for you, like totally changing the way you see yourself, the direction you see yourself going in, and yeah, that was the goal of the song.”
